After due notice was given, the Charlotte County Board of Supervisors held a Joint Public Hearing with the Charlotte County Planning Commission to receive public comment on a Conditional Use Permit submitted by Moses Swarey to erect a sawmill on his property located at 2373 Germantown Road, Charlotte Court House.

Chairman Walker for the Board of Supervisors called the meeting to order with William V. Nichols, Second Vice Chair of the Planning Commission calling the meeting to order.

Monica Elder, Staff Representative for the Planning Commission addressed the Board with a brief overview of the project proposed by Moses Swarey.
