CHARLOTTE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
PPEA COMMENT PERIOD

The Charlotte County Board of Supervisors has received and accepted for evaluation an unsolicited Public-Private Education Facilities and Infrastructure Act (PPEA) proposal for the construction of a multipurpose facility at the Phenix and Bacon District Elementary Schools from Jamerson-Lewis Construction of Lynchburg, Virginia. In addition, the proposal included the construction of eight (8) classrooms for Phenix Elementary School that would replace the existing mobile units which have exceeded their useful life. On March 14, 2018 the Board of Supervisors published a public notice and advertised for competing proposals for a period of 45 days as required by the Charlotte County PPEA policy. The 45-day solicitation period ended April 30, 2018 at 2pm.

The Charlotte County Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on Tuesday, May 8, 2018 at the Charlotte County Administration Office, PO Box 608, 250 LeGrande Avenue, Suite A, Charlotte Court House, Virginia to receive comment from the public regarding the proposed projects.

In accordance with the Charlotte County PPEA Policy, the public comment period will remain open until the close of the business day on June 7, 2018. Comments must be submitted in writing to the Charlotte County Administration Office at the above address and must be received no later than June 7, 2018.
