County Administrator Daniel Witt welcomed everyone and introduced Randy Jones and Hunter Wilson with OWPR Architects and Engineers, the firm that worked with the County's School Facility Evaluation Committee to assess Bacon District and Phenix Elementary Schools and provide recommendations for Phase II renovations.

Randy Jones and Hunter Wilson provided a PowerPoint presentation which included an introduction to their firm, an overview of the study's purpose and their approach, a discussion of assessment areas, and renovation plans and estimates for both schools.

OWPR then opened the floor for questions from the Board of Supervisors and the School Board. Questions presented related to the need for structural monitoring, increases in estimated costs for items such as roofing & HVAC, and increases in overall construction costs.

Mr. Witt expressed the School Facility Evaluation Committee's support of OWPR's report. He explained that the next step in the process would be for the School Board to consider the report and then provide a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors.
